St Andrew's College, in conjunction with the South African Schools Rowing Union, invites you to the South African Schools Boat Race to be held on the Kowie River in Port Alfred from 6-8 December 2012.

The SASRU body will be subsidising the running of the Boat Race this year but it does mean a small increase in the entry fee. The entry fee will increase to R 1100 per boy's crew and R 650 per girl's crew.

The Regatta will include two events, namely:

A Junior Men's Eights race over 6,4 km. The time trials will be held on Friday afternoon and the Finals will be held on Saturday morning. This event is open to all school's boys First VIII crews, but excludes any current matrics.

A Junior Women's Quads race over 4 km. The time trials will be held on Friday and the Finals will be held on Saturday morning. This event is open to all school's First Quad crews, but excludes any current matrics.
