A Junior Men's Eights race over 6,4 km. The time trials will be held on Friday afternoon and the Finals will be held on Saturday. This event is open to all school's boys First VIII crews, but excludes any current matrics.

A Junior Women's Quads race over 4 km. The time trials will be held on Friday and the Finals will be held on Saturday. This event is open to all school's First Quad crews, but excludes any current matrics.
